INITIATIVES:

- a. Organized the group of former members of Marist Brothers (MAREX) as Marist Mission partners.
- b. Started the Green University Program of the Notre Dame of Marbel University as an answer to the Marist Educators' Congress Resolutions of 2010. One of the resolutions was the desire to find new and creative ways to educate the young and to have common advocacies which affect especially the environment and to intensify zero waste management.

The program was intensified with the creation of the Green Schools, an organization of Koronadal City schools and institutions that promotes the care and protection of the environment and humanity.

- c. Initiated the Marist Administrators Formation program for the present and future administrators of the Marist institutions in 2011 with the following objectives:
 - i. Develop competence, integrity and accountability in administering a Marist School.
 - ii. Learn the basic principles and pedagogies of Marist Educational leadership as well as its Marist culture, values and practices.
 - iii. Appreciate the values and roles of Administrators as part of the mission of the Church.

A total of 4 batches were conducted, the latest of which was in 2019.

- d. Initiated the "Abante Lumad Scholarship Program," a program of NDMU that raises funds to financially support the college education of poor but deserving indigenous college students in South Cotabato.
- e. Started the socialized education program in NDDU Integrated Basic Education Department in Espina campus which makes Marist Education accessible to the poor.
- f. Initiated programs for Women Development (for College Female Students) and for Peace and Environment in the two Marist Universities.
