



Workshop 2 Personal Growth Workshop


Description.

Description.

Being every human being sacred ground, with a methodology that incorporates several models, the personal growth workshop (PCT) is focused on integrating two aspects of the human being: on the one hand, the vulnerable (which is painful and often prevents him/her from unfolding fully as he/she wishes) and, on the other hand, the positivity that we will call Manantial, namely those qualities, positive forces and capacities that make him/her stand up and continue fighting for his/her desires..

Goal.

"The aim of this workshop is to provide a space of deep knowledge that allows us to recognise and work on the process that has been violated, and to welcome and strengthen the well of positivity, acquiring tools to fully develop the human dimension, the basis of any life option."



Methodology

- a) Presentation of the exercise through a brief explanation.
- **b)** Time for personal work with the questioning material provided. For this moment it is necessary that the participant has physical space and time in which he/she is not interrupted, so that he/she can connect, feel and realise.
- c) Sharing the fruit of personal work in life groups. These smaller groups are formed with the participants themselves, with a member of the facilitating team accompanying the group. In order for the group to achieve its objectives, it is recommended that the participants know each other as little as possible so that they feel free and confident to share the fruit of their personal work.
- d) Sharing of the fruit in the large group (this is called a plenary) and closing of the exercise.
- e) **Space for interviews and personal accompaniment during the workshop.** The objective of this space is to name, elaborate or process what the participant is discovering and which, sometimes, is not easy to express in the life group or in the plenary. All interviews will take place on one or two specific days of the workshop, depending on the number of participants. The schedule of the interviews will be adjusted with each participant individually.

- ☆ Update: I hurt where I have been hurt and disproportionate reactions.
- ☆ Wounding and sexuality.
- ☆ Introduction to the well. Exercise: My qualities through action
- ☆ Dynamics of the Vase and Sleeping Beauty.
- ☆ History of my victories and great trials
- ☆ Harvest and theory of the Spring.
- ☆ Intimacy with God from my personal story.
