Our Superior General - Bro. Ernesto Sánchez Barba, announced on the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, the decision of the General Council to appoint Bro. Venceslas Baindekeli Beimoyato as Provincial of the Province of Central East Africa for a period of three years. In the words of the Superior General,

Bro. Venceslas will start his mandate as Provincial on the occasion of the celebration of the Provincial Chapter of PACE, to be held from 14th to 17th December 2021.

Prior to that announcement Brothers of that Province participated in the sondage for the appointment of the new Provincial.

The Superior General expressed gratitude to the outgoing Provincial Bro. Théoneste Kalisa for his service as Provincial for the last six years.

Blessings come in various forms. This was witnessed on on the 12th of June 2021, at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Trede, about 2 kilometres from the Novitiate Community. Twenty Marist novices from the Marist International Novitiate, in Kumasi - Ghana (aka Marist Formation Centre, Sabin-Akrofrom) made their first profession. It was for the first time in the history of the Kumasi Novitiate that up to twenty (20) Novices committed themselves to their Religious Vows at a time.

The occasion was on the celebration of the Golden Jubilee of Bro. Denis Ntacycia, the Silver

Jubilee for Bro. Boniface Chirambo and Frank Mwambucha as well as the Platinum Jubilee of Marist presence in Malawi. The colorful event took place at Marist Secondary School in Dedza.

It was noted that the Marist presence has contributed greatly to the formation of young people through education at Secondary School level. The Provincial Councillor of Malawi for the Province of Southern Africa Bro. Francis Jumbe was grateful to God the Almighty for his

protection to the Marist Brothers and their colaborators for the 75 vears of service to mankind. He mentioned that despite the challenges that the early missionaries faced such as tropical diseases, they withstood them with the guiding grace of God. This has led to the reward of 34 local Marist Brothers who have joined to serve in the vineyard of the Lord Jesus Christ as local missionaries.

The Provincial Councillor who is also the acting headteacher of Marist Secondary School thanked the government of Malawi for giving Marist Brothers the platform to help in the development of the country through education. He expressed the need for improvement of the education of the girl child:

"Our target is now focusing on improving girl' education after noticing that most girls drop out of schools due to reasons that can easily be solved by for instance constructing boarding schools."

The article takes note that the Congregation of Marist Brothers was founded by St Marcellin Champagnat and the first missionaries went to Malawi in 1946. The Marist presence is in 79 other countries in which Marist works speak volumes about education delivery and evangelization in the ways of Mary.
