NEW BUILDERS OF THE HERMITAGE

COURSE FOR FORMATORS 2024 IN MANZIANA

n the context of the celebration of the bicentenary of the construction of the Institute's mother house of Notre Dame de l'Hermitage, in France, the Institute has implemented a formation program called "New Builders of the Hermitage", for brothers who will be qualified for the pastoral mission of supporting the formation processes in the various houses and stages of initial formation in Marist life. The course has been prepared by the Brothers Today Secretariat and by a team specially formed for this program, made up of Brothers Juan Castro (MDA), Michel Maminiaina (Province of Mada-



gascar) and César Rojas (Province of Norandina). The course will end on Sunday, November 24th, in France, at l'Hermitage. We share some words from the Brothers in Manziana.

The Brothers gathered at the General House on February 1st, but on February 4th, brothers from the General house came including Br. Ernesto Sánchez Superior General for the official opening ceremony of our program. We are totally 21 participants from 15 different countries including a Marist father Fr. Mikaele Misinale

who is attending the same course as well as a Chaplain. After the Mass we were welcomed and accepted for the program by giving us the logo of "New Builders of the Hermitage" by Br. Ernesto and the General Councilors to all of us.

On 2nd Feb, we went to join with our Pope to celebrate the

In addition to Brothers Jorge Gaio, Econome General, and Goyo Linacero, Assistant to the Econome, also participating are Alfie Custodio (East Asia), Alejandro Cebrian (Ibérica), Bernard Kenna (Star of the Sea), Ivo Cadaval (Brasil Sul-Amazônia), Ir. Luck Paul (Nigeria) and Ir. Xavi Giné (Hermitage). Also participating were Everson Oliveira (responsible for the Domus system) and Brother Josep Lluis Martí, translator.
- On the same days, a group of Marists from Italy, made up of brothers and laypeople, will be guests at the General House for a formation course.

Speakers are coming from different parts of the Marist world also, the translators. & Br. Emili Turú, and Br. Juan Antonio Diego, a Brother from Saint Jean of God, shared their wisdom on our inner journey and spirituality.

Brothers Lindley Sionosa, Luis García Sobrado, and at present Br. Teófilo Minga are helping us as translators.

We had our community meetings and planned for our community life by sharing necessary responsibilities. We are trying our best to live as an international community with the richness of our culture and Marist experience.

A NEW AND FORWARD LOOKING INITIATIVE OF THE MARIST YOUTH

nited by the motto "Together we dream of the future", the first Marist Youth Day was held at Marist Spirituality Center – Santiago de Chile (Province of Santa María de los Andes) from February 22 to 24.

This initiative was organized by a group of eight former students with the support of the Laity Team of the Chile Sector and brought together 22 young people between 19 and 30 years of age.

The objectives of the meeting were:

- 1. To generate a first meeting space for young people, from 19 to 30 years of age, who are linked to the Marist through service and community experiences.
- 2. To celebrate life and the road travelled, becoming aware of one's personal history and the stage of life in which each one finds himself.
- 3. To propose among all those present, on the basis of a first draft, various ideas of participation and sustainable organization for the present and future of young Marists in the country.

The dynamics of the day combined personal reflections, playful activities and community dialogue with a set of experiences that revolved around three axes: looking at my past; becoming aware of my present and projecting my future with others. In addition, a proposal for a formative itinerary was presented that includes a series of suggestions for development in the human-spiritual, fraternal-community and mission-service areas, within a framework of respect for Marist values and the personal processes of each participant.

This is a novel and forward-looking initiative:

 It generates a simple structure of Marist animation that aims to accompany the life of young people of this age range.



- The proposal is totally conceived, organized and animated by a "generating team" of young people of the same age. The Laity Team fulfills a function of institutional support and advice.
- It aims to bring together all young people who wish to participate, who adhere to Marist values, regardless of their faith process.

The results of this process have motivated this "Generating Team" to continue its work this 2024 with the intention of adding more people and thus develop a path together with other young people who share Champagnat's ideal of generating communities of life at the service of the most needy and marginalized.




OTHER MARIST VOICES 45 AND 46:
