OPENING MOMENT OF THE JOURNEY AND ORGANISATION OF THE GROUP

1. Objectives:

- a) To present an overview of the proposal and the process of the International Forum on the Lay Marist Vocation and, specifically, its local phase.
- b) To get involved and play an active role in the experience of the International Forum.
- c) To organise the internal dynamics of the group meetings that will be the venue for the dialogue and reflection of the International Forum in its local phase.

2. Process

a) Motivation Activity

- The group gathers in a circle and places a large image of the Forum logo (without the text) in the centre. (see appendix)
- In addition, each member of the community has a marker pen and two medium-sized pieces of paper to write on.
- The facilitator invites them to look at the image in silence and asks: What do we imagine when we see this image? What comes to mind when we look at it?
- They write down one idea on a piece of paper using one or two words. If they have a second idea, they use the second piece of paper. They do this in silence, without sharing.
- When the facilitator indicates it, everyone places their papers around the logo and reads what they have said.
- They are invited to share their feelings and impressions of the fruits of the activity.
- This leads to the reading of the letters...

b) Shared reading of the letter of invitation from Br. Ernesto Sanchez and the introduction from the Secretariat of the Laity. Reactions to these are shared. (see annexes).

c) Overview of the Phases of the International Forum on the Lay Marist Vocation. (the powerpoint may be helpful)

d) Organisation for the meetings:

It is important for the group to make a plan to ensure good progress on the proposed work of reflection and to be able to meet the deadlines. The Province Lay Ministry Team may give other indications suited to the local context and organise the process differently. In any case, we suggest that the following points be agreed upon at this meeting:

- Review the resources for the meetings: 4 on topics and 1 to prepare a summary,
- Organise the way they will meet (virtual or face-to-face),
- Draw up the timetable for the meetings,
- Allocate the time needed for each of the meetings according to the topic sheets,
- Share out the roles (leaders, secretaries, prayer ...),
- It is very important to define the role of the Secretary well, because in each meeting he/she will be the one to take notes of the ideas expressed, particularly the "personal, community and provincial calls". The secretary will keep them for use in the "Final Summary".
- Appoint drafters of the final report,
- Talk about how to participate in the Provincial/District Forum and the date of the Forum.



3. Prayer:

We propose that you end the meeting with a simple prayer where everyone can freely share what is in their hearts for this process of the International Forum.

Finally, in union with our Global Charismatic Family, the group prays the prayer for the Forum.
